Position Responsibilities

Specific duties will include the following:

- Develop story ideas and write final content for publication, adhering to Mzalendo's style and editorial guidelines
- Ensure that all content meets the organization's standards for 100% accuracy and balanced reporting
- Verify facts, dates and statistics using standard reference sources;
- Adapt news stories for dissemination across various social media platforms: Facebook and Twitter
- Work closely with the program team, researchers and partners while producing content
- Outline, write and edit weekly blog posts;
- Research and compile weekly newsletter;
- Develop compelling headlines and email subject lines, with online readers in mind;
