The Constitution provides thre following to be the job of your Member of Parliament:

ROLE OF THE MEMBER

1. Represent you and fellow Kenyans, including special groups, in the constituencies;

- 2. Discuss issues that concern you;
- 4. Discuss about tax payers money and decide
- how much the national and county government, including state organs will get;

3. Make national laws;

5. Keenly monitor the President and Deputy President and other state officials and ensure that they respect and implement the Constitution;

6. Start a process of removing the President,

Deputy President and other state organs

- from office if they fail to respect the Constitution; 7. Checks on how the Cabinet and Ministries spend money and ensure our money is spent properly

175 members spoke less than 10 times accounting for 50% of the House
